



Karim is a permanent searcher for unique terroir expressions. Abras is the first chapter of a long story that began when he fell in love with Cafayate, a high elevated desert in Salta at 1700 m.a.s.l (5577 f.a.s.l), cradle of Torrontés, and also of great Malbecs.

We source fruit from vines that are over 30 years old, planted on alluvial soils at the bottom of the valley, getting more mineral and genuine expressions.

In the same way the Incas used the ABRAS as roads to navigate the Andes mountains, we use this elvish portal to have access to the beautiful wine world of the Calchaquí Valley.
